

Course Title: Internship with a Business Unit

Course Code: 507

- **Definition:** An internship is a supervised practical experience in an industrial, governmental, academic, or virtual environment with the purpose of enhancing the technical, managerial, and communication skills for students in the Symbiosis School of Economics.
- **Course Objectives:** The first objective of the course is to give students real-world experience in a workplace setting where the students can employ their economic knowledge. The internship is to be a learning experience and it is expected that the interns will receive mentoring on-the-job. It is not expected that they will be paid for the internship. The second objective of the internship course is to learn about the economics of the workplace
- **Scope:** The length of the practical experience should exceed 150 hours. Students will be required to write a work report on their practical experience in order to obtain credits. Evaluation of the experience will be based on that report and on a report by the supervisor of the intern. An internship has to complete.....
- **Credit:** No more than two credits of internship will be accepted to satisfy degree requirements.
- **Internship Assistance:** Students may find their own internships or may check with the college for recommendations. The internship must be lined up and approved by the Head or Faculty-in-charge by the end of the Mid-semester Examination.
- **Internship report:** The student should write a report which addresses the following topics
 - A description of the environment in which the practical experience takes place. In most instances this will be a description of a company or government unit.
 - A description of the practical assignment.
 - A description of the accomplishments of the intern during the practical experience.
 - An evaluation of the effectiveness of the internship. In particular, describe the areas in which knowledge and skill enhancement took place. Where appropriate, note where intern expectations were not met.
